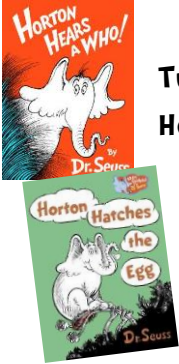
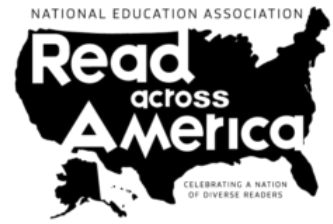
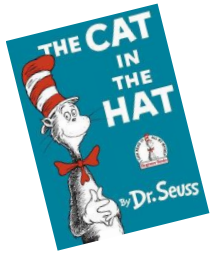
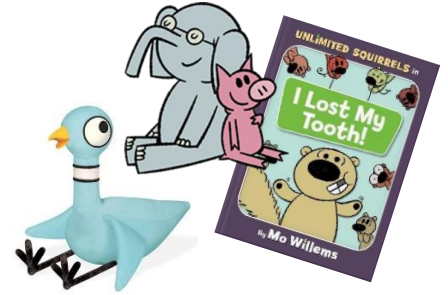


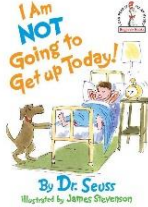
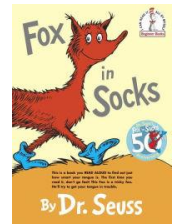
Read Across America March 1-4
