Kindergarten Roundup 2021-2022

Kindergarten registration for all elementary school in Polk School District will be held February 22, 2021 through March 5, 2021. Parents/guardians may pick up a registration packet at the school you are zoned for anytime during the day from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Packets are also available on the Polk School District website under the Kindergarten/Pre-K Registration tab.

Your child must be five (5) on or before September 1, 2021 to attend Kindergarten.
**** All current pre-k students must register for kindergarten**

Registration packets and copies of the documents below must be returned to the school no later than 3:00 p.m. on Friday, March 5, 2021.

For your child to be registered, state law requires the following information:

1. **Certificate of Live Birth** (certified copy NOT the hospital copy or copy of live birth)
2. **Immunization Certificate; Form 3231** (obtain from the Health Department or Pediatrician) or **appointment card showing an upcoming appointment scheduled.**
3. **Hearing, Vision, Dental & Nutrition Certificate; Form 3300** (obtain at the Health Department or Pediatrician & Dentist) or **appointment card showing an upcoming appointment scheduled.**

Pre-K students must have a new Hearing, Vision, & Dental Certificate for Kindergarten Registration.

4. **Copy of Child's Social Security Card** (this will be your child's school ID number)
5. **Utility Bill** (power, gas, or water to show proof of residency)

If your child has an out of state birth certificate, it must be a certified copy with a state file number.

If you have a non-certified copy of your child's birth certificate, you will need to apply at the Vital Statistics Office in the state the child was born. This process takes six to twelve weeks to receive a new birth certificate. Please take this into consideration and do not wait until the last minute to obtain.

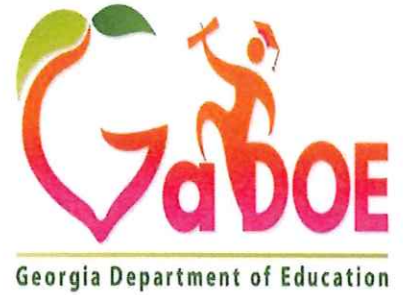
