***ADVANCED PLACEMENT TESTING CRITERIA***

1. An information session shall be held in the spring for parents and students registered for Advanced Placement classes for the upcoming school year. This session will outline program benefits, expectations, rigor, and testing.
2. All students enrolled in an Advanced Placement class will be afforded the opportunity to take the test if he/she is passing the class in January before the test administration.
3. Parents will be provided a letter outlining the testing payment expectations, as well as test participation option in January.
4. All Advanced Placement classes must have a Final Exam which will count as 20% of the grade (based upon PSD Board Policy).
5. All Advanced Placement classes shall meet for all remaining classes after the AP Exams.
6. GaDOE will pay for one test for any student participating in the Free or Reduced Lunch Program.
7. Polk School District will pay for one test for any student.
8. Parents/Guardians are responsible for payment of test above and beyond what the GaDOE and PSD pay.
